This electrical safety audit has been authorised by Energy Safe, the independent statutory authority responsible for ensuring the safe supply and use of electricity in Victoria.

Energy Safe licenses electrical workers, registers electrical contractors and audits Certificates of Electrical Safety to ensure a licensed electrician has performed the electrical work properly according to safety regulations.

Energy Safe aims to maintain high industry standards while also providing Victorians with peace of mind.

Safety is our priority

Electrical safety audits of electrical work are an important service provided by Energy Safe at no cost to Victorians. These audits may identify anything from minor technical non-compliance issues to significantly unsafe or defective electrical installations.

If a technical or an unsafe issue is found in relation to the electrical work under audit, the electrical contractor will be notified and requested to immediately rectify the defect at no cost to the owner/occupier of the property.

Your auditor

The auditor visiting your property is employed by an inspection company and is one of the authorised contractors engaged by Energy Safe to conduct audit inspections of electrical work on behalf of the safety regulator.

You can identify the auditor by their identification card, which will be visible and available for you to view on request.

Certificates of Electrical Safety

Certificates of Electrical Safety must be provided to the customer for any electrical installation work in Victoria. The Certificate of Electrical Safety states that electrical installation work may be subject to audit by representatives of Energy Safe.

In addition to ensuring the electrical work is safe and compliant, the safety audit confirms the Certificate of Electrical Safety provided is valid.
