# Orange Book 2024

# **Consultation report**

Energy Safe Victoria consulted on draft *Victorian Traction Industry Electrical Safety Rules* from 23 April to 3 June 2024, on behalf of the Victorian Railway and Tramway Electrical Safety Committee. This document is also known as the Orange Book.

## **Engagement summary**

On Tuesday 23 April Energy Safe CEO Leanne Hughson emailed 27 traction industry stakeholders to advise the consultation period was open. The consultation period closed 3 June 2024 and generated:

- 121 web page views
- 69 downloads of the draft guideline
- 6 written submissions.

# Themes of submissions

- · Consideration of the adoption of AS300 requirements
- Grammatical and formatting changes for readability
- · Consideration for companies to gain approval from Energy Safe when varying requirements of the code
- Requirements for training timeframes being explicit at 3 years
- Clearance distance in Table 1 changed to align with the regulations (Column 2 final row)
- Inclusion of 3.3kv as this is a voltage used in the industry.

## Our response to submissions

- All change suggestions and submissions were recorded and discussed by the Orange Book changes sub-committee of the Victorian Railway and Tramway Electrical Safety Committee
- · The suggestions were either agreed or rejected by the sub-committee
- The persons that provided submissions during the consultation period were contacted by phone or email after the sub-committee had reviewed all submissions, with the decisions of the sub-committee explained
- The agreed changes were endorsed by the Victorian Railway and Tramway Electrical Safety Committee
- The final Orange Book 2024 has had legal review and endorsement by the Victorian Energy Safety Commission.
